

Memo To All CISVA Elementary School Principals and Coaches

After three years we are excited to be finalizing plans for the CISVA Track and Field Championships. Again this year, it looks like we will have close to 2800 children participating in the meet. While Swangard Stadium is a fantastic venue for the meet, it does pose challenges with regards to parking.

In the past Burnaby Parks and Recreation has outlined several problems that have occurred concerning parking. These problems have taken place in both the west and east parking lots and surrounding areas.

- Vehicles were parked in the emergency access road and in front of the emergency gates creating a possible dangerous situation.
- Vehicles were double-parked blocking in other vehicles.
- Vehicles were parked on grass areas down Kingsway by the Lawn Bowling facility, causing damage to the grassed areas.

Vehicles parked in the east and west parking lots of the stadium are only allowed to park in marked stalls and once filled, drivers need to find legal and appropriate parking in other available areas. If possible carpooling, transit and alternate means of transportation are encouraged.

There will not be any warnings for parking violations - cars will be towed away at the owner's expense.

Our ability to book Swangard Stadium for the future events is dependent on the cooperation of all. Thank you for your understanding.
